Grievance

The Grievance Committee generally meets for 1-hour each month as needed.

The Grievance Committee reviews complaints alleging Code of Ethics violations and requests for arbitrations, forwarding cases to the Professional Standards Committee for hearings. There are nine positions, each appointed for a three-year term. Members must be an active REALTOR® member for two years to be eligible to serve on the Grievance Committee. Appointed members must attend a Board approved Professional Standards Training program and be willing to serve on the Professional Standards Committee for a three-year term at the end of their Grievance Committee term.

The Governmental Affairs Committee generally meets for one hour, once a month as needed.

Term Length: One year

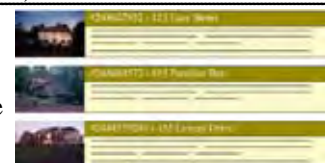

Multiple Listing

The Multiple Listing Committee generally meets for one hour, once a month as needed.
