Continuing Education
Tips and Requirements for Real Estate Licenses**

- You **MUST** obtain continuing education credits **EACH** year of the 3-year license cycle. The easiest way to ensure that you meet the license renewal requirements for continuing education is to complete at least 6-hours of continuing education (including the mandatory 2-hour legal update) **EACH** year.
- Verify that the courses you complete are approved. You **DO NOT** receive credit for courses that are not approved by the state. You also **DO NOT** receive credit for duplicate courses.

- Check your continuing education credits online. This way, you can ensure that all your hours are posted correctly. This cycle's approved courses begin the letter "K".

- There is no "first year" waiver for continuing education. You are required to complete continuing education in the year that you obtain your license.
- You may choose to send your license back to the State of Michigan if you will be "inactive" in the business for a while. This will change the status of your license on the Department Website. When you want to practice again (have an active license), you **MUST** complete the required continuing education requirements.
